To prepare for May's class, please gather the following.

- [Basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- kit of supplies from a scrapbook manufacturer. May used [this kit](#) from K & Co.
- kit of supplies from a kit club. If you don't belong to a kit club, the kit that May uses is available in limited quantities for purchase at Scrapbook.com.
- various coordinating items from a single manufacturer. May used the [Scarlet's Letter collection](#) from Basic Grey.
- cardstock
- patterned paper
- alphabet stickers and/or rub-ons
- embellishments (such as ribbon, chipboard, and brads)
- photos

Note: more information on the kits mentioned above and on class preparation is provided in the pre-class handout available to all students immediately after registration. Please remember that supplies you have on hand will work, too. Though May used the kits above, substitutions can be easily made with any supplies you have available. Using up your existing stash of supplies is highly encouraged!



Optional supplies
