

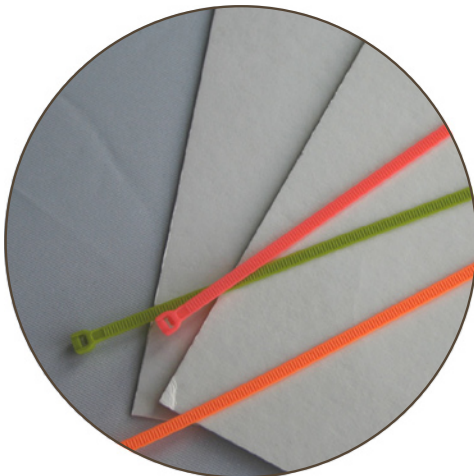

When you do need help or additional supplies, we believe the personal attention at your local scrapbook store can't be beat. To prepare for Stacy's class, please gather the following supplies for a 6" x 6" handmade book:

- [basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- computer and color printer (optional)
- two pieces of cardboard (matboard, chipboard) cut 8" wide by 7" tall
- two or three zip ties (can be purchased in a hardware or home improvement center.)
- ten to fifteen page protectors (6" x 6" size.)
- four sheets decorative paper
- miscellaneous dimensional elements, like letters, tags, tabs, brads, etc..
- dimensional adhesive (glue dots or a fast-drying liquid glue)
- unifying element like ribbon, paint, decorative tape, rub-ons, etc. (something you will use on every photo page.)
- black archival pen for handwritten notes.
