Materials for Amy's class:

- [Basic Tool Kit](#) (to purchase items like these click [here](#))
- three colors of chalks ([option 1](#), [option 2](#), [option 3](#))
(these colors will become the color scheme for your layout)
- three sheets of either 8 1/2" x 11" or 12" x 12" white or off-white cardstock (depending on which size layout you prefer)
- one sheet 8 1/2" x 11" or 12" x 12" colored cardstock that matches one of your chalk choices
- one sheet small alphabet rub-ons or stickers
- one sheet large (at least 2" tall) alphabet rub-ons or stickers
- ribbon or floss that matches or compliments one of your chalk choices
- six to ten colored mini brads that match your color scheme
- chalk applicators [I use Q-tips and cotton balls]
- a piece of scratch paper at least 3" x 5"

You will also need ...

water, paper towels, and a shallow baking pan or tray: the chalk technique I am teaching will cause the chalk to stain, so make sure the pan is not one you care about.
