If you are not using the CK Media Kit, you will need to gather the following to prepare for Robin's class:

- [Pine Cone Press 5" x 7" Album Tin Kit](#) (or you can substitute by using any size album you choose) [Albums](#)
- [corner rounder punch](#) (optional)
- [We R Memory Keepers Crop-A-Dile](#) (optional)
- a collection of patterned paper that you love
- eight to ten sheets of cardstock to be the background paper for your book (paper size is determined by your album; mine are kraft colored)
- a variety of coordinating frames and tags
- ribbon that coordinates with the product you selected
- a variety of embellishments and attachments
- two free internet download fonts: [hootie](#) and [Angelina](#)

This supply list is very generic because I want you to feel free to make this project unique to your love story. Your project may vary from mine depending on what photos you are able to find and what you want to describe with the most details. For example, you may choose to spend two pages writing about how you met, while I only spent one page on that topic. You will adjust your book to match your photos and the stories that you want to share.

Note: You can create a book by yourself, or the two of you can create it together in a "he said/she said" format. My husband wrote his side of the story in our book and I liked hearing his perspective. You may consider duplicating the book at a later time so that each of your children may have a copy. You may also want to create this book for a couple that you love, and leave room for them to fill in the journaling (or, better still, ask them to respond to some questions and put their answers in the book for them) - what a unique wedding or anniversary gift!
