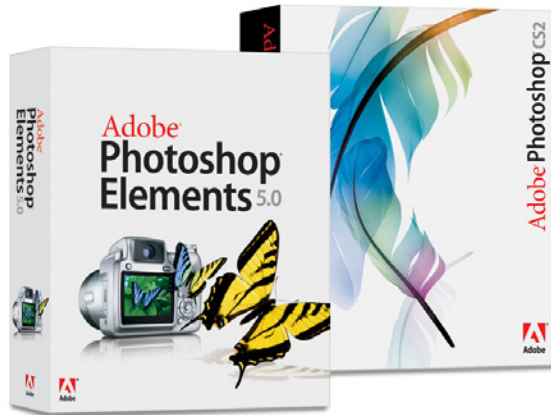

- a computer (Mac or PC)
- Adobe Photoshop Elements 4.0, 5.0, or 6.0 or Adobe Photoshop CS3. (Renee will not be able to support or assist students with older versions of these programs.) **You can [download](#) a free, 30-day trial version of Adobe Photoshop Elements or Adobe Photoshop from the Adobe website.**
- a color printer
- 8.5" x 11" inkjet compatible white matte photo paper or cardstock. I prefer Epson papers, especially if you have an Epson printer. But your favorite paper is fine.
- 8.5" x 11" binder and notebook paper to hold your downloaded workshop instructions, handouts and notes.
- an assortment of embellishments (brads, buttons, ribbons, eyelets, paper flowers, etc.) if you'd like to add these to your digital pages. please don't purchase anything special in this category - just use what you have on hand!
