## THE TOOLS:

- circle cutter (I used the [Coluzzle](#) & [nested circle template](#) by ProvoCraft, but any circle cutter that allows you to make circles approximately 4 1/4" in diameter will work).
- sandpaper or emery board.
- [Bind It All binding system](#) & [3/4" o-wire](#) - OR - hole punch & loose-leaf binder ring.
- wire cutters or kitchen shears.

## THE MATERIALS:

- one 12" x 12" sheet of thin chipboard (like the kind that comes in an online paper order).
- one sheet of 12" x 12" patterned paper for album covers (I used "Let's Boogie" from the [Prima Peaches](#) line).

- five sheets of 12" x 12" cardstock - can be all the same, or a mix of complementary colors (I used Bazzill "[Grass Green](#)").
- one sheet of coordinating 12" x 12" patterned paper for page accents (I chose a graphic black and white pattern that would look good cut into strips - "[Sleeping In](#)" from the Luxe Classic Black line).
- letter stickers (I used the [Making Memories black Shimmer Alpha](#)).
- approximately 12" of ribbon.
- a pair of (clean) chopsticks.
- your favorite adhesives (I used a 5" Xyron and quick-dry tacky glue).

**OPTIONAL:**

- a cute takeout box from the gift wrap section of your local craft store.
