**To prepare for Mamie's class, please gather the following supplies:**

- [basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- sewing machine (optional).
- computer and color inkjet printer.
- rotary cutter, such as Olfa, self healing cutting mat, and grid-marked quilting ruler, such as [Omnigrd ruler](#) (these are helpful, but not mandatory).
- iron and ironing board.
- [Bo-nash pressing sheet](#).
- 11" x 14" frame (size may vary, if you wish; however, instructions in the handouts refer this size).
- medium to heavy weight [fusible interfacing](#)
- fabric "paper", such as [EQ Printables Inkjet Fabric Sheets](#).
- double stick fusible web, such as [The Warm Company Steam A Seam 2](#).
- five to nine [coordinating pieces of fabric](#) (scraps will work, and can be as small as 5" x 6", as long as they can be cut into several 2" squares).
- one to three photos in digital format, cropped, edited and ready to print (but DON'T print them yet!).
- coordinating flat embellishments, such as ribbon, safety pins, stamps, ink, paint, eyelets/snaps... (more on these in class!).
